CHARITY. If we are to open our hearts to Christ, our hearts must be aflame with charity. It is easy to see an equivalence between charity

and almsgiving. Almsgiving refers to all forms of charitable outreach to those who are in need - the outreach we engage in as Knights putting the needs of others ahead of our own. Through charity, we become more like Christ, who gave himself up for us and for our salvation.

UNITY is crucial for the health of the Order. Only when we are united can we fulfill our mission to empower Catholic men. Living our faith is like a team sport; we can only do it together. But our unity depends not merely on our goodwill, but rather on our oneness with God, attained through prayer. Lent is a training ground for prayer. For us as Knights, it is a time for us to unite in living our faith.

FRATERNITY. As Knights, we value brotherhood and solidarity. We know that sustaining solidarity sometimes requires patience and forbearance.
