

NOTE from the Pastor, Fr. Dean.

To answer some questions: 1. Health and wreck.

Monday evening I passed out, not from alcohol use but from low heart rate, as I was wrongly taking a double dose of metoprolol as prescribed by pharmacy on its label. Metropolol regulates blood pressure but also lowers heart rate. Instead of taking a full pill in the morning as listed on the pill bottle, I should only have been taking ½ or less at night and not at all if heart rate gets below 60. Anyway, low heart rate caused fainting or blackout and I totaled my car against the Napa sign. Seeing the school sign stating I was going 31 mph, and no hurry to get four more blocks to the rectory, I couldn't fathom what happened to have hit that sign pole with such force as make such an impact. Blacking out, the weight of foot is still on accelerator. Fortunately, I destroyed only my car and a Napa Sign from the ordeal and no other person/s involved.

I am grateful to the Onstar program calling for emergency assistance, the EMT's and especially to Alan Mendenhall for (as he rightly told my brother the next day) "convincing this stubborn man to go via ambulance to the hospital."

Due to the fainting, I am not permitted to drive for two weeks for medical and safety reasons. Thus I require a driver to get me somewhere as needed such as to the 8:30 am Mass at St. Mary's this Sunday; and a doctor's appointment next Tuesday morning.

Other frequent Q's: On July 1, 2023, I will be living in my duplex in Effingham, 602 N. Fourth Street. I will be available to fill-in upon request by pastors of any Diocesan parish, including from Fr. Pawel. I plan to make numerous pilgrimages/tours in the future which presently include trips to the Holy Land in August and in October. I may take up pickle ball or try to play racquetball twice a week!

Streaming Masses: Likely not to continue as I will be taking my phone with me!
