As we celebrate the joyful mystery of our Savior's birth, may the peace of the newborn Jesus Christ fill your hearts, the blessing of our Mother, the Virgin Mary, protect your homes, and the strength of St. Joseph, Guardian of the Holy Family, guide you in the year to come. I wish each of you a grace-filled Christmas and a Happy New Year 2026.

This Christmas is especially meaningful to me, as it is the first time since 2019 that I have the opportunity to celebrate with my family in Poland — something I haven't been able to do for the last six years. Can you imagine being away from your family and friends during the Christmas season? I believe it would be very difficult for many of us. Yet our faith and trust in Jesus Christ remind us that within the Catholic Church we belong to a greater, divine family. No one should feel abandoned or alone, especially when far away from home. Wherever we may be in the world, our Catholic family celebrates Christmas in the same spirit and with the same faith. This truth helped me realize that whether celebrating Christmas with my family in Poland or in Newton and Ste. Marie the theological message carries the same spiritual depth.

Christmas reveals to us that God enters our world with humble love—a love that brings light to darkness, hope to weary hearts, and comfort to all who seek Him. From my personal experience I want Christ to be born in my heart no matter where I might be. I want Him to bring salvation, peace, and strength to my life. As we gather around the manger, may we rediscover that Christ is Emmanuel—God-with-us—walking beside us in every moment of life no matter where our life might be or what point of life we might be. Just to let you know that I carry all my parishioners in my heart and in my prayers.

May this holy season inspire us to share His love generously, especially with those in need, and to strengthen our parish community in compassion, unity, and peace.
