Emails have been sent to each family with a 2nd grader prepared for 1st Reconciliation. The original date for this group of students to receive Confirmation/First Communion was set for October 21, 2023. Fr. Dean will be in the Holy Land on that day and the U of I has its major band contest also on that day, so Fr. Dean has arranged for an earlier date of June 3 for the 28 families of St. Thomas Parish and June 17 for the 5 families of St. Mary parish. This is due to the Bishop limiting the number of candidates for any one Mass at 80. There were 30 spaces left for June 3 and 6 spaces left for July 17. If there is a conflict, we will make arrangements for your son or daughter to be confirmed & receive First Communion on another day.

LENTEN REGULATIONS:

Abstinence: All the faithful who have reached 14 years of age are required to abstain from meat all the Fridays of Lent.

Fasting: All the faithful between the ages of 18 and 59 inclusive are bound to fast on Ash Wednesday and on Good Friday.

To disregard completely the law of fast and abstinence is seriously sinful. However, health and/or medical needs dispense a person.

Clergy Overnight Gathering with the Bishop

At the meeting we listened to the proposals regarding Catholic School Education. The pastors of the Springfield Catholic Schools have decided to implement a set base tuition for all families. The pastor will meet with his parish families to encourage the family to attend Mass at his/her home parish and if attending 51% of the weekends, a scholarship would be provided the student. Families from other parishes attending the school could receive the same from their parish. This may be the model for the future of all Catholic Schools in the Diocese for as the Bishop stated, the Catholic School, in fact all Catholic education, is to promote Catholic Disciples of Jesus.

On October 28, 2023, the Diocese will celebrate the 100th anniversary of the transfer of Diocese from Alton to Springfield with a Mass at the Convention Center in Springfield. No parish masses, no weddings, funerals will be scheduled on that Saturday.
