In observance of the 11th annual National Day of Remembrance for Aborted Children, pro-life individuals will gather at gravesites and memorials dedicated to honoring the memory of aborted babies. This event serves as a poignant reminder of the countless lives impacted and lost, following the Roe v. Wade decision in 1973.
