Altar Bells Are Ringing...

Before Fr. Pawel left for Poland he expressed to the Pastoral Council that he wanted to incorporate the ringing of altar bells during the Liturgy of the Eucharist. Most of the other parishes around the area already do this, and with guidance from Fr. Tomy (and a few brave servers), they have recently been implemented into the Mass.

Altar bells are approved for use in paragraph 150 of the General Instruction of the Roman Missal and serve a meaningful purpose during Mass. When the Holy Spirit is called down and the consecration takes place, the bread and wine truly become the Body and Blood of Christ. At that moment, the ringing of the bells draws our attention and awakens our hearts to the mystery before us, the moment when Heaven and Earth meet at the altar for the supper of the Lamb.

It's something that has returned to St. Thomas and St. Mary's after many years, and is rooted in ancient Church tradition. Let the ringing awaken your soul to deeper reverence and awe at the real presence of Jesus in the Eucharist.
