Part II: Last Sunday we celebrated Corpus Christi,

which honored the real presence of Jesus in the Holy Eucharist. For us Catholics, Mass is not the typical social gathering. It is a holy and sacred encounter with God. This is especially true during the Liturgy of the Eucharist. In that sacred moment of the Mass, Heaven touches Earth. Every word and gesture, and silence have deep meaning. We gather together in Communion to receive His true presence, Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity, so that He may dwell within us; to strengthen and unite us with Him and with each other as one holy, Catholic, and Apostolic Church. But be present during the entire Mass with your heart prepared and spirit ready. Make every genuflect, bow and sign of the cross as reverent as you would if Jesus were standing before you, because He is not just present when you receive Him in the hand or on the tongue. He is always present before you in the Tabernacle. While in the church after Mass, be mindful of those around who may still be in the pew, trying to pray to God. That sacred encounter with Him doesn't just stop after Mass has ended. So, whether it's before, during or after Mass, we remain reverent for He is always with us. Christ is Lord. We are in His house and He is always home.


